The Highland Township Board of Supervisors (BOS) met on this date at 7:30 p.m. as publicly advertised, at the Highland Township Municipal Building, 3641 Fairfield Road, Gettysburg, PA 17325.

CALL TO ORDER:

JS called February 10, 2026, meeting to order at 7:30pm.

POLICE, FIRE AND RESCUE:

The following reports were reviewed: PSP (Dec & Jan), AREMS (Dec, Jan, Year End 2025), Cashtown Fire Dept. (Jan), Gettysburg Fire Dept. (Profit & Loss 2025), Fairfield Fire Dept. (Dec, Jan and Year end 2025).

APPROVAL OF TREASURERS REPORT:

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

JS made a motion to accept Parks/Patriot waste contract Option 1 for weekly solid waste removal, large item pick up, bi-weekly recycling removal and 2 covered device drop-off recycling for annual cost of \$378. Contract runs April 1, 2026-March 31, 2029, with provision of a one-year extension. Also available is standard per bag service of \$72 per year for 12 bags with option to purchase additional bags at \$6 per bag. Wheeled 96-gallon toter may also be rented at \$25 per year. CY seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

BB motioned to approve without review the Weikert subdivision with the following condition: No improvements will occur in Highland Township. CY seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

ADJOURNMENT:

JS motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:55pm. CY seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.
